GRADING PROJECTS

Highway 2—Sixth Lane Construction

Project involved grade widening (including utility coordination, land acquisition, legal survey) for existing four lane section of Highway 2 to six lanes.



- Upgrades to all interchange ramps, highway frontage road accessing restaurants, fueling stations and a Safety Rest Area.
- The Hwy 2/2A/72 interchange was reconfigured to eliminate existing loop ramps to allow the 3rd lane to fit the existing bridge opening
- The construction of two intersection treatments to accommodate revised left turning movement to access Hwy 2.
- Street lighting at two interchanges.
- Management of two Department borrow sources

Highway 1 and Highway 22 Interchange Revision

Spanning two construction seasons, Eagle worked with Bow Mark Paving to realign the third highest rated collision prone interchange in the Province.

- Revised geometry of exit and entrance ramps along Hwy 1.
- Remove loop ramps & upgrade existing loop ramps to meet design standards.
- Grade widening along Hwy 1 to accommodate increased ramp lengths for safer traffic merging.
- New interchange street lighting and upgrade to existing high mast lighting system & traffic signals.
- Removal of overhead sign structures and cattlepass structures.
- Installation of two new overhead structures on Hwy 1 including Destination signage to match revised ramp configurations.
